



Pre-Admission GUIDELINES for
**Bachelor of Education
Secondary (Humanities Stream)**

Admission into the Bachelor of Education Secondary program requires completion of a 4-year bachelor’s degree. TRU students typically prepare for entry by completing a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of General Studies focusing on English or Social Studies.
