Apply online at **truworld.ca/apply**Upload required documents (transcripts, language proficiency, etc.). Application fee: \$100 CAD.

3 ACCEPTANCE

Receive a Conditional Letter of Acceptance (CLOA) within 10-15 business days (undergrad) or 4-6 weeks (grad).

4 PAYMENT

Pay tuition deposits through PayMy Tuition by bank transfer, debit, or credit card at **tru.ca/pay**

5 OFFICIAL ACCEPTANCE

Receive your Official Letter of Acceptance (LOA). TRU obtains your Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) on your behalf (if applicable).

6 STUDY PERMIT

Apply for your study permit with your LOA and PAL using BorderPass at TRU.


